

Attention Employees:

Sharkheads and Souvenir City reopened on Monday, April 27th, and with state and local governments both lifting restrictions on retail business we have resumed normal operations. There has been a large spike in business and to meet the demand we have to get our staff back to work.

Effective Friday May 8th all employees formerly furloughed due to the CoVID-19 pandemic are expected to report back to work. We will resume scheduling you your normal hours as demand meets. If for any reason you can not return to work, you need to let Brent and/or Abe know immediately.

We know that many of you have applied for and have received unemployment benefits. For full disclosure, we have to let you know that this might effectively end those benefits, but we are required to open these positions back to the employees we furloughed. Ultimately it will be your responsibility to let the Unemployment Office know your jobs have been offered and you have returned to work. We will have to update the Unemployment Office that all jobs have returned. If for any reason you decide not to return to work, it will still be your responsibility to update your status, letting them know you refused work. If you continue to receive benefits while work has been offered it could lead to you having to repay these benefits and any fines associated with it back to the state.

We understand that this has been a hard time for everyone. We have been trying hard to work with everyone and get back to some sense of normalcy. We are going to continue to follow CDC guidelines with social distancing, and cleaning contact surfaces, as well as any new guidelines that may arise.

Thank you all for your patience and understanding. We are looking forward to seeing you back here.
